### ➤ Information for authors

The editors of JAE welcome the submission of full-journal or short manuscripts. Peer-reviewed and accepted full-journal manuscripts will be immediately published online in JAE under J-stage, Japan's largest platform for academic e-journals. Detailed information of the two types of manuscripts is shown below.

- ✓ Full-journal manuscript  
Full-journal manuscripts must contain new and timely contributions from any areas of atmospheric electricity and related fields, and can be submitted anytime.
- ✓ Short manuscript  
Short manuscripts present details of the research results reported in SAEJ's annual meetings which are basically held in January of every year. A short manuscript must be equal to or less than six pages on its first submission without limit for references. The due date of the first submission is the end of May every year. Peer-reviewed and accepted short manuscripts will be published in October.

- Manuscript preparation

Manuscripts shall be written in English or Japanese. In the case of a Japanese manuscript, its abstract and figure caption shall be written in English. Authors can download a Microsoft word file of the full-journal or short manuscript template from <https://www.saej.jp/entry/jae.html>. After a manuscript is accepted, its authors will be required to provide the final version of the manuscript, a photo-copied version for publication.

- Submission

- Publication charge

No charge for any manuscripts.

- Copyright

The copyright of all manuscripts published in JAE belongs to SAEJ. Once a manuscript is accepted, authors will be required to submit a signed copyright agreement form to publish the manuscript.
